676 Apparitions of Killoffer to hit book stores Spring 2006

Charting Killoffer's violent odyssey through a world overflowing with his many selves, *676 Apparitions of Killoffer* is a spectacularly ambitious attempt to roll back the constraints of autobiography and graphic narrative.

Originally published in French by L'Association in 2002, *676 Apparitions* is widely recognized to be one of the key European graphic novels of past years. It was short-listed (along with Chris Ware's *Jimmy Corrigan* and Daniel Clowes' *David Boring*) as Best Album at the Angoulême International Comics Festival in 2003.

A journey from Paris to Montreal takes on Dantesque proportions, as Killoffer is besieged by six hundred and seventy-six apparitions of his own self. Multiple Killoffers rampage across the pages, on a jaw-dropping spree that spills over with horror and dark humor.

The English edition, presented in the same large format and re-lettered by the artist, will be pre-released to the comic book store market in December, in advance of its general release.
